

Summer Internship Optional Housing Information

PWSE Summer Interns are responsible for their own housing and meals during the 8-week program. There will be several luncheons, a breakfast, etc. that will be paid for by PWSE as part of the program. All other meals, snacks, etc. for participants will be the responsibility of participants.

PWSE will once again arrange with the Department of Residence to have space set aside in [Frederiksen Court apartments](#), which are located on the north side of campus and are only a fifteen-minute walk to most major campus buildings. Full payment for room and board must be made via check to the Program for Women in Science and Engineering prior to completion of the program.

For planning purposes, the total cost for the 8-week 2008 PWSE Summer Internship was 996.00 and included:

- A space in a 2-bedroom apartment (2 people per bedroom for a total of 4 people in each apartment) (\$15.50 each day per person) for a total of \$896.00
- Frederiksen Court Long-Term Academic Program residents are required to have a \$100.00 Dining Dollar program.

As soon as the exact costs for the 2009 PWSE Summer Internship Program are known, we will update this information.

Note: Parking permits may be purchased to in the Frederiksen Court parking lots; permits will cost approximately \$45.00 for the summer.
